## Now, Iemma evicts Tweed Seniors

Tweed Nationals MP Geoff Provest has pleaded with the Premier for a stay of execution for the Banora Point residents of 30 units who have received eviction notices demanding they leave their homes in Yarra Court, Banora Point.

"It is ridiculous that these local pensioners are being thrown out of their homes by Morris Iemma's Department of Housing," Mr Provest said.

"This is a classic case of bureaucracy gone mad. We have a desperate public housing crisis in the Tweed after years of Sydney neglect."

"When the Government finally goes and give us a trickle of funding, it starts by evicting 90-year olds who have nowhere else to go but back on the waiting list."

"I want the Premier to provide adequate funding for Tweed public housing and I want him to consult locals on how he goes about it. Obviously a green field site is a more acceptable solution to all."
