Its official: Kingscliff and Tweed restaurants are the best

“doing the Tweed proud and attracting visitors and jobs...”

Tweed Nationals MP Geoff Provest today offered a saving tip for Tweed gourmets: “don’t travel to Brisbane or Sydney, the best restaurants around are right here in Kingscliff”.

Mr Provest was speaking after Kingscliff, Casuarina and Murwillumbah business scooped a record number of NSW Restaurant and Catering Awards for Excellence at a gala night at Peppers, Kingscliff on Monday night.

Fins of Kingscliff won the major Restaurant of the Year award, also picking up prize for Best Seafood Restaurant and being named as a finalist for Best Wine List.

The best pizza restaurant in northern NSW is the Sea Salt Ristorante Pizzeria and the Best Speciality Restaurant is the Kathmandu Kitchen also in Kingscliff.

The Bamboo Restaurant & Lounge Bar in Casuarina Beach was named Best Contemporary Australian Restaurant, while the Murwillumbah-based White Olive Restaurant won top awards for two of its apprentices.

Mr Provest said the businesses were not only ‘doing the Tweed proud’, but their success would generate publicity which in turn would bring more visitors and jobs to the Tweed.
